Dear Parents/Carers,

We want to keep the disruptions to the children's learning to a minimum, which is why we are sending your child home with this pack of activities. Please do not do them all in one go! We will be sending an email daily, first thing in the morning, that outlines things that could be completed from the pack over that day and also suggesting other activities that could be carried out at home that the children would have done at school. We would like you to take a photo of the activities that you do and upload them to EvidenceMe as a way of you sharing things that you have done with your child that we can respond to. We will also send details about websites that you can go to that would support the learning. Also, we plan on emailing you some videos of us reading or teaching each day too!

Personal hygiene is the most important way we can tackle COVID-19, especially washing hands more. Public Health England recommends that in addition to handwashing before eating, and after coughing and sneezing, everyone should also wash hands after using toilets and travelling on public transport.

The health and safety of the children, staff and wider community has to be our priority and we have to play our part in preventing the spread of the virus.
