Dear Parents and Carers,

On the back of my letter that I sent on Monday and following government announcements, I wanted to keep you fully up to date with the current plans we are making. As always, it is crucial that we keep communicating to each other and if you have any worries or concerns you know that I am always here to listen them.

This week, as a Trust, all of the Primary School Headteachers met online and we continue to talk to each other every day. We are working hard to ensure that children can return to school when it is safe to do so and we will only do this when we feel we are ready to. This is very important for all in our school community.

As part of our preparation process, all schools will be undertaking a thorough risk assessment review of the school premises which will be undertaken by an external company Bellrock. Our site audit and risk assessment for Meon Vale will happen today, Friday 15th May, and the purpose of this is to ensure that every reasonable adjustment to maximise the safety of our community has been actioned.

The outcome of this review will enable us to share clarity with you as families about the systems and processes we will be putting in place once school re opens. Well-being is integral to our planning for both students, staff and families.

Once we have had our on-site risk assessment, we will be contacting you and sharing more detail about the measures we will be putting in place to ensure that school operates as safely as possible in the current situation. We will also be asking for your views about children returning to school. We will share this information with you by Friday 22nd May.

Once we have collated all parent responses and planned our course of action following the risk assessment review, we will communicate with you when school is planning to open for the designated year groups (in our case nursery and reception). We will also be able to give you clarity about timings during the school day and the school week in general.
