Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome to Seedlings Class! I hope that you have had an enjoyable summer and would like to extend a warm welcome to you all. The children have settled very well, and we have had a great induction week getting to know each other.

The adults in Seedlings this year are:

Strachen and **Miss Smith** – Playworkers.

When dropping off your children please ensure you arrive between 8:30am and 8:45am.

A teacher will be standing at the door with a Nursery diary at drop off times and collection times. Please give us any messages at this time. If your child is being collected by someone other than you, we will record this information. Please let us know of any other adults that you are happy for your child to go home with, such as Grandparents. If you are stuck in traffic or need to make a last-minute change to your collection arrangements, please call the school office on 01789 721 060. If you haven't told us of any changes, we will not let your child go home until we have spoken to you.

Water: Your child will need to have a named bottle of water (not juice, squash or fizzy drinks please) that will be available to them throughout the session. Water and cups will be provided for those who forget.

Lunch Bags: If your child is staying for lunch and having a packed lunch, we ask that you clearly label the outside of their lunch bag. Please refer to the 'Lunchbox Guide' for tips on what to put in your child's lunchbox. We advise against chocolate, and sugary snacks. Please also ensure that no peanuts are included in the lunchbox (peanut butter sandwiches and snackbars etc.).

Book-bags: These are an important part of school life as they help to bring home books, pictures and letters. Please provide your child with a named school book-bag and ensure your child has their book-bag or rucksack in class every day. Please check it regularly for letters.

Snack Time: Children have milk or water to drink at this time. We also have fruit daily and will encourage the children to try a variety of fruits. Please let us know about any food allergies.

Toys: Please do not bring toys into the Nursery as they can easily get lost or broken.

Topic: Our topic this half term will be '**In to the Woods**', a topic web can be found on the reverse of this letter. This includes activities you can do at home with your child to complement the learning they do at school.
