Weekly Update

Dear Parent/Carer(s),

Firstly, I would like to thank families for their support with our new parking arrangements. We have seen a significant increase in the number of families using the side gate, which has helped to ease congestion and improve the flow of people arriving and leaving the school site. We are always looking at ways we can further reduce pressure around the main entrance and appreciate your ongoing support as we continue to review these arrangements.

This week, we have also undertaken a reset of our behaviour expectations during breaktimes and lunchtimes. Whilst children have made an excellent start to the academic year, it is important that we continue to reinforce our expectations and ensure that the playground remains a safe, positive and enjoyable environment for everyone. Staff have spent time revisiting routines, discussing expected behaviours and celebrating those pupils who consistently demonstrate our school values. The children have responded positively, and we are already seeing the impact of this renewed focus.

Our Open Event will take place on Saturday 3rd October from 10am to 12pm for families interested in joining Meon Vale in September 2027. Whilst this event is primarily aimed at children who will be starting school in the 2027/2028 academic year, we also have spaces available within some of our current Reception and Key Stage 1 classes.
