Our History unit 'How has travel changed?' from the Autumn Term allowed the children to explore the changes to both travel and transport within living memory. This planned visit will help to reinforce and consolidate learning and support our pupils to learn more and remember more through this first-hand immersion into the history of travel and transport.

The trip will have a focus of 'Journeys Through Time'. Pupils will experience what it was like to own one of the first cars and to drive on Victorian roads, through exciting costumed role-play and a tour along the Museum's 'Time Road'. They will explore the collection of over 150 historic vehicles including a 1920s London bus complete with conductor! Children will also learn how the development of the motor car has changed the way we live our lives over the last century.
