Week Beginning – 08.02.21

Spring Term 1 – 'Once Upon a Time'

Weekly Topic – The Magic Paintbrush

Day	Activities
Monday 8th	<p>9.15am – Phonics Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. - Play Boggle. Children will need a whiteboard for today's session. - What would you paint if you had a magic paintbrush? Children paint picture. - Write a matching sentence to accompany picture.</p> <p>11am – Maths Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. <u>Learning Intention</u> – Explore the composition of numbers to 10 – Combining 2 groups Play a Numberblocks game about adding: https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/puzzles/numberblocks-adding-up-quiz?collection=sports-quizzes Try the robot addition game where you can add numbers within 10, 15 and 20 depending on confidence: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/addition/robot-addition Challenge – to create your own Maths addition sums and number sentences as shown in the live session.</p> <p>2.30pm – Show and Tell and Story Sharing Please join us at 2.30pm for our first 'show and tell' session! If you have something that you have made or done that you are proud of – this is the session to tell us in! Please press the hand button on TEAMS and we can have turns at sharing. I predict this session to be longer than usual! After that, please join us for a story chosen by Harrison!</p> <p>Other things that you could try over the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Don't forget to read at home each day – sharing a story or having a look at your school books.- Linking to the story of 'The Magic Paintbrush' and Chinese new year – can you make a dragon head today (just the head we will make a tail tomorrow). You could use cardboard boxes, toilet rolls, card and lolly sticks. Here's some examples: 

<p>Tuesday 9th</p>	<p>9.15am – Phonics Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. - Revisit alphabet looking at capital letters. Play alphabet game. http://learnenglishkids.britishcouncil.org/games/abc-count.down - Play 'Silly Soup using ur words. - Play 'The Dinosaur's Eggs' + ur. http://www.ictgames.com/dinosaurEggs_phonics/mobile</p> <p>11am – Maths Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. <u>Learning Intention</u> – Explore the composition of numbers to 10 – Doubling Numbers Watch Numberblocks episode about doubles: https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08q4jkq/numberblocks-series-2-double-trouble (Double Trouble) https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08dmhm6/numberblocks-series-1-the-terrible-twos (Terrible Twos) Using your number cards and blocks/cubes/other items to help you. Pick a number from 1-5 Count out an amount to match this number. Then double it by counting out the amount again. How many do you have altogether? Challenge further Record your results of you doubles on a table. Do they notice a pattern with these results?</p> <p>2.30pm – Craft and Story Time Miss Wright will start this session by showing you how to now make a tail for your dragon head that you created yesterday. We will read a story after this session.</p> <p>Other things that you could try over the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Why not try retelling the story with some masks today! I have included some templates on TEAMS – but you could always create your own ones! - Making the dragon's tail from the 2.30pm live lesson!
<p>Wednesday 10th</p>	<p>9.15am – Phonics Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. - Play https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/3/sentence-substitution-ph3 - Practise letter formation and write an ow sentence. - Print and complete the ow crossword.</p> <p>11am – Maths Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. <u>Learning Intention</u> – Explore the composition of numbers to 10 – Taking away Play a subtraction game by tacking away items from the tree https://content.connect.collins.co.uk/Content/Live/ElektraMedia/Busy_ants/Foundation/GamesandTools/30_IMT_Tree/index.html Repeat game with real life objects / cubes etc. Generate your own start number from 1-10 and then parents to create a number to take away (keep it simple to 1 or 2 at first). Write this as the number sentence e.g. 7 – 3 Model how to count out cubes to match the first amount (in this case 7), but with subtraction we are not adding more cube we need to take away the cubes (in this case 3). How many do we have left? Write in the answer (4) Repeat with other amounts. Challenge – mix up with some addition sums to help with familiarity of the + and the - symbols</p>

	<p>2.30pm – Scavenger Hunt and Story Sharing Mrs Cotton will start this session by playing a scavenger hunt with you! You will need a box or a basket for this session. We will then read a story after this session.</p> <p>Other things that you could try over the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have another look at the Magic Paintbrush story - Here is an online version of the story https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=z-0JZPzBDMc - Have a go at reading a story from the Oxford Owl site today!
<p>Thursday 11th</p>	<p>9.15am – Phonics Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Play cupcakes game. Put cupcases in baking tray. - Print and play ‘oi Connect Five’ game. Connect five real ‘oi’ words before your partner does. <p>11am - Maths Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. <u>Learning Intention</u> – To understand the concept of time, days of the week and months of the year. Watch the days of the week song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mXMofxtDPUQ Watch the months of the year song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Fe9bnYRzFvk Print or write out the days of the week and months of the year and order them – you could use the song to help. Sort the months into 4 seasons and draw items that link to this season.</p> <p>2.30pm – Drawing and Story Session Mrs Cotton will play a game of ‘Listen and Draw’ before the story today. You will need a piece of paper and some pens/crayons. Please then join us for a story chosen by Poppy!</p> <p>Other things that you could try over the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Today would be our day where we would be doing some PE in the classroom! <p>Friday 12th</p>	<p>HAPPY CHINESE NEW YEAR! It is the Year of the Ox.</p> <p>9.15am - Phonics Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tricky word reading and writing. - Have a piece of paper/whiteboard and pen ready for a tricky word quiz. - Print / write out Word List 13 – now, down and my. <p>11am – Maths Please see TEAMS for the live streaming. This will also be available after the session. <u>Learning Intention</u> – To understand the concept of time, days of the week and months of the year. Discuss at home when things occur within your normal day to day routine. You could draw a mini timetable. Talk about where in your house you have clocks – on walls, tv, oven, watches etc. Why is time important?</p>

Look at a clock and the O'clock hours. When do things occur over the day?
Play the 'Time Bingo Game' on TEAMS to become familiar with reading O'clock times.

2.30pm - Story Sharing

Please join us at this time for a story read by Miss Watkins followed by the announcement of our 'Star of the Week!'

Other things that you could try over the day:

- Friday name writing practise – have a go at writing your full name again today, we try to practise this weekly in school too.
- Joe Wicks is continuing with his PE at home sessions – he does these on a Monday, Wednesday and a Friday. The Friday ones are great because they are in fancy dress! You could join with him after your phonics session today.
- The keyworker bubble will go out for their walk today! We like to have a look at the building site of our new school and comparing photos from the week before. It's exciting to watch the progress of the building! If you can, why not take a walk there today too and observe what is going on. Don't forget your wellies!
