Children will be taught to master basic movements including throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and coordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

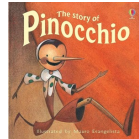
HISTORY



Travel and Transport

The children will be looking at how modes of transport, via water, air and land, have changed over time. We will be able to explore the Wright Brothers, Amelia Earhart, and George Stevenson. Finally, the children will compare the past, present and future of transport and travel.

ENGLISH



Focus Text:

Pinocchio by Carlo Collodi

The children will be introduced to adjectives, repetition, time adverbials, the conjunction 'because', and verbs. These tools of writing will then be used when the children complete their independent write; a retell of part of the story.

ART



Drawing and Painting

To explore the work of Claude Monet (drawing) and Yayoi Kusama (painting).
To know about and explore primary and secondary colours to create a colour wheel.

PSHE



Being me in my world

The children will begin to understand that actions have consequences. We will then begin to know what is needed to feel safe and to belong to a class.

SCIENCE



Animals including humans

The children identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which parts of the body is associated with which sense.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

What is a Christian and what do they believe?

Children will learn what a Christian is and what they believe. They will develop an understanding of the Christian creation story.

COMPUTING



Online safety and key computing skills

Develop an understanding of how to keep safe online. We will develop key computing function skills such as logging on, using a word processor and saving work.

MUSIC



Action songs and body percussion

Children will learn how to create a simple melody and be able to follow a leader when starting and stopping musical performances.
