RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

What can we learn from sacred books?

The children will learn about the books that are sacred for Christians, Muslims and Jews. They will learn why the stories within these sacred books are important to these religions.

GEOGRAPHY



What do we know about Stratford-upon-Avon?

In this unit, the children will explore Stratford-upon-Avon. They will locate the town on a variety of maps and will understand that it is in the county of Warwickshire, which is in the United Kingdom, in Europe. They will learn about human and physical features and will identify examples of these within the town.

PSHE



Being Me in my World

In this unit, the children will discuss their hopes and fears about the academic year ahead. They will understand their rights and responsibilities as a member of the class and the school. They will discuss the importance of listening to and respecting other peoples' views and opinions.

ENGLISH

Focus Text: 'Little Red Reading Hood' by Lucy Rowland



The children will explore this text by learning about the key moments in the story and writing about them. They will then write their own story based upon this text by changing the main character.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Sending and Receiving

The children will develop their knowledge of space and will learn how to accurately pass and receive balls using different parts of their body. They will also practise aiming towards a given target.

COMPUTING



Information Technology Around Us

The children will learn about the many uses of information technology at home, at school and in the world around them. They will explain the benefits of it and will also learn about the risks of going online. The children will also learn about how to use technology safely and respectfully.

SCIENCE



Animals, including Humans

The children will look at how animals change as they grow through the introduction of life cycles. They will also be introduced to the basic needs of animals for survival, as well as the importance of exercise and nutrition for humans.

ART



Drawing and Painting

The children will learn about primary and secondary colours and how to make tints and shades of a colour. They will also explore the art of Kandinsky and will create their own art in the style of this abstract artist.

MUSIC



Charanga 'Pulse, Rhythm and Pitch'

The children will learn about pulse, rhythm and pitch and will explore how these musical elements combine when we sing and play music.
