PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Gymnastics

Children will be taught to develop balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these when using a range of Gymnastics apparatus.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

Moving Pictures

The children will design purposeful and functional products exploring mechanisms, such as levers, sliders, wheels and axles, to create a moving Christmas cards.

<u>MUSIC</u>
