RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times?

The children will identify a special time they celebrate and will explain what 'celebration' means to them. They will learn about the Jewish festival of Hanukkah and the Christian nativity story whilst considering the symbolism of light within these festivals.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Sending and Receiving

The children will create movement patterns to perform dances. They will develop control, coordination, balance, poise and elevation in the basic actions of jumping, turning, gesture and stillness.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Animal Puppets (sewing)

Linked to our Science learning about living things, the children will design, make and evaluate an animal puppet.

HISTORY

Why is Stratford famous?

In this unit, the children will learn about William Shakespeare and why he is such a significant historical figure from their own locality. They will explore life during the Tudor times by learning about Shakespeare's life and finding out about his family and his childhood. They will also consider the impact that Shakespeare has on our everyday lives today.

PSHE

Jigsaw – Celebrating Difference
In this unit, the children will identify
similarities and differences between people in
the class. They will explore and discuss how
difference should be accepted and celebrated
and they will consider how our differences make
us special and unique.

COMPUTING

Creating Media: Digital Photography
The children will learn to recognise
that different devices can be used to capture
photographs. They will gain experience of
capturing photographs in landscape and portrait.
The children will also edit and improve
photographs they have taken and will use this
knowledge to recognise that images they see may
not be real and may have been edited.

MUSIC

Charanga 'Pulse, Rhythm and Pitch'
The children will learn about pulse, rhythm and

pitch and will explore how these musical elements combine when we sing and play music.
