MATHEMATICS



Multiplying and dividing by 8 and 10.
Reasoning and problem solving skills using multiplication and division.
Multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number.

ENGLISH

We will be exploring two texts this half-term. The first is 'Theseus and the Minotaur'. The children will write their own myth at the end of this unit. The second is an explanation text: 'How a Robot Dog Works'. The children will create a persuasive piece of writing at the end of exploring this text.

SCIENCE



Plants

In this unit, the children will explore the structure and functions of plants. They will undertake investigations involving plants including exploring how plants transfer water.
They will also get opportunities to learn about the process of seed dispersion and the plant life-cycle.

MUSIC

The children will be learning 'The Dragon Song' and will perform the song at the end of the unit. They will be participating in warm-up games which will allow them to identify the beat.



LATIN



The children will be using their previous knowledge to recognise and write present tense verbs in Latin.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Why are festivals important to religious communities?

The children will learn how and why people from different religions celebrate religious festivals. They will explore the significance of these festivals and why they are celebrated around the world.



D&T

Cooking

Pine class will be learning about seasonal foods and how we can incorporate those foods into our diet. They will also get the chance to cook some yummy seasonal treats!



GEOGRAPHY

Where do our natural resources come from?

In this unit, the children will explore their local community by discovering where their natural resources come from and where they could come from.

We will be discussing how resources such as food, water and energy can be sourced in different ways.



PSHE



Healthy me

In this Puzzle the class talk about the importance of exercise and how it helps your body to stay healthy. They also talk about their heart and lungs, discuss what they do and that they are very important. The children talk about calories, fat and sugar; they discuss what each of these are and how the amount they consume can affect their health.
